**A Resolution To Award a Sidewalk Repair Contract**

**WHEREAS**, the City is responsible for maintenance and repair City rights of way; and

**WHEREAS**, sinkholes have developed in the City controlled sidewalk adjacent to 7810 Glenarden Parkway and 7938 Dellwood Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to repair the sidewalks as soon as possible to avoid further damage and to protect the public; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has received Proposal Number 09032008 from Concrete Masters, LTD, a copy of which is attached to this Resolution, that it believes is fair and reasonable in the circumstances for repair of the said sidewalks; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council has determined that an emergency exists that affects the public health and safety and that it is appropriate to exempt the award of this contract from statutory bid requirements under Section 826 of the Glenarden Charter.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Glenarden, Maryland sitting in Regular Session this 8th day of September, 2008 as follows:**

1. That a contract be and it is hereby awarded, as per the attached Proposal 09032008, to Concrete Masters, LTD for the repair of the sidewalks adjacent to 7810 Glenarden Parkway and 7938 Dellwood Avenue in the total amount not to exceed Three thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$3600.00); and
2. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute the said Proposal, and take such further action as may be necessary, appropriate or advisable to effectuate the foregoing resolution; and
3. Concrete Masters, LTD, shall be required to file a Certificate of Insurance with the City prior to beginning any work; and
3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately.
