A Resolution to Establish a Grant Program for the City of Glenarden Homeowners Associations

WHEREAS, President Joe Biden signed the 1.9 trillion American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) to aid public health and economic recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the ARPA funds are being distributed to the states who is then distributing the funds to municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Glenarden has accepted the one time option to use the ARPA funds as lost revenue; and

WHEREAS, this option allows for more flexibility when it comes to addressing City needs; and

WHEREAS, ARPA funds can be used to assist non-profit associations; and

WHEREAS, Homeowner Associations (HOA) are considered non-profits; and

WHEREAS, within the City of Glenarden there consists six Homeowners Associations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Glenarden, Maryland sitting in Regular Session this th day of April 2022 as follows:

1. That the City of Glenarden establishes a grant program to assist Homeowners - Associations.
2. That each HOA can apply for a grant based on criteria and qualifications set down by the Mayor and City Council.
3. The maximum amount of each grant to any HOA will be \$60,000.
4. That \$300,000 be set aside from the ARPA funds to fund the program
5. The following HOAs are eligible to apply for a grant:
 - a. Glenarden Forest Homeowners Association
 - b. Glenarden Frost Homeowners Association
