That the City of Glenarden establishes a grant program to assist Homeowners -36 Associations. 37 2. That each HOA can apply for a grant based on criteria and qualifications set down by the Mayor and City Council. 38 3. The maximum amount of each grant to any HOA will be \$60,000. 39 40 4. That \$300,000 be set aside from the ARPA funds to fund the program 41 5. The following HOAs are eligible to apply for a grant: a. Glenarden Forest Homeowners Association 42 b. Glenarden Frost Homeowners Association 43
