Fareed; 8 Councilwoman 9 **November 15, 2022** Public Hearing: 10 **Regular Session** Session: 11 November 21, 2022 Date of Introduction: 12 13 14 A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A SPECIAL FUND KNOWN AS THE 15 GLENARDEN GOOD SAMARITAN HARDSHIP FUND TO REDUCE THE 16 IMPACT OF ECONOMIC HARDSHIPS ARISING FROM THE PANDEMIC 17 CAUSED BY THE CORONAVIRUS IN THE CITY OF GLENARDEN. 18 WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, the federal government enacted Public Law 117-2 (the 19 "American Rescue Plan Act of 2021" or "ARPA") to provide additional relief to address the 20 continued impact of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 ("COVID-19") pandemic on the 21 economy, public health, state and local governments, individuals, and businesses; and 22 WHEREAS, President Joe Biden signed the 1.9 trillion ARPA to aid public health and 23 economic recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic; and 24 WHEREAS, the ARPA funds are being distributed to the states who are then distributing 25 the funds to municipalities; and 26 WHEREAS, the City of Glenarden has accepted the one-time option to use the ARPA funds 27 as lost revenue; and 28 WHEREAS, this option allows for more flexibility when it comes to addressing City's 29 needs; and 30 WHEREAS, due to numerous mitigation measures recommended by the federal and state 31 authorities and subsequently imposed by the State, City of Glenarden residents continue to 32 suffer from the economic hardships of various kinds; and 33 WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and City Council to further ameliorate these 34 economic hardships to the extent possible and to supplement the ARPA with other funds 35 available in the City's General Fund; and 36

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 602(a)(26) of the Charter of the City, the Glenarden City Council 37 has the authority to expend federal or state grant funds for any public purpose; and 38
