That Article III, Chapter 149-22.1: Commercial vehicle parking restriction be and is hereby amended to read as follows: 36 37 38 § 149-22.1 **Commercial Equipment parking restrictions.** 39 40 A. No person shall park any commercial equipment or other tractor, trailer, or tractor trailer combination, upon any public or residential property, except for 41 42 the purpose of making local deliveries to said property.

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| 44 | B. No Person shall park any commercial equipment or other tractor, trailer or |
| 45 | tractor-trailer combination, having a gross weight in excess of 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ tons, upon |
| 46 | any commercial property unless the vehicle is registered in the name of the |
| 47 | property owner and used in the identified business of the property owner. |
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| 49 | C. A violation of any provision of said article shall be cited as a municipal |
| 50 | infraction, subject to a fine of \$200 payable to the municipality by the person |
| 51 | charged in the citation within 20 calendar days of the summons. |
